



LEVELr™ WALL CLADDING SYSTEM

PRODUCT DATA

LEVELr is a sophisticated wall cladding system that pairs a frameless panel aesthetic with extensive material options. Smartly detailed at every turn, LEVELr makes it easy to create a high-end design statement without resorting to custom solutions. Panels accommodate many different F+S Surfaces, including VividGlass, without a visible framing element. Narrow reveals between panels keep the installed look clean. For added refinement, optional 1/8" proud stainless steel fins can be incorporated between panels—a detail unique to LEVELr that lends an exquisite, contemporary finish. Bases and inside and outside corners expand the customization potential. In addition, the system's 2" depth provides room to manage wiring, electronics and air flow between the wall and panel backs.

For design continuity throughout a space, the LEVELr Wall Cladding System coordinates with our LEVELr Column System. Many of the same high-performance materials available for LEVELr are also available for F+S doors, elevator interiors and doors, sheet goods and more.


The LEVELr Wall Cladding System can be specified for many field conditions. Panel shapes and sizes can vary according to specification and field requirements. LEVELr panels and corner components have sufficient tolerances built into them to accommodate the majority of out-of-square conditions or other dimensional irregularities.


STANDARD MATERIAL OPTIONS

VIVIDGLASS	STAINLESS STEEL
VividGlass laminated glass has tremendous creative potential. Offering numerous ways to transform spaces with colors, patterns and graphics, many of our VividGlass designs can be specified as for panel faces including selections from our ViviChrome, ViviGraphix, ViviSpectra, ViviStone, ViviStrata and ViviTela families. A variety of optional patterns, applied to the stainless steel/finish combination, can also be specified for added visual interest and enhanced functionality. Impression and Fusion patterns bring dimension to the surface; eco-friendly Eco-Etch patterns offer a wide array of standard designs and vast customization potential. FUSED METAL	ELEMENTAL METAL
Fused Metal is Forms+Surfaces' exclusive line of colored stainless steel. Created by fusing titanium alloys to the stainless substrate at the molecular level, Fused Metal provides the durability and low maintenance of stainless steel in a rich range of colors. Elemental Metal pairs the performance benefits of stainless steel with the timeless beauty of oxidized metal. The finishing process creates organic variations in the material's appearance while also increasing the fingerprint resistance and maintenance ease of the material. These fluctuations in tone add visual depth and result in subtle shifts across individual sheets and from one sheet to the next. The standard color is Elemental Carbon. BONDED METAL	BONDED QUARTZ
Bonded Metal castings are light in weight yet extremely durable. The material's high relief, highly detailed surfaces have the character and appearance of solid metal. A wide range of patterns, metal colors and patinas offer a striking breadth of design possibilities. Please refer to the Bonded Metal Product Data Sheet for complete information.	Bonded Quartz combines ceramic microspheres and a fiber-reinforced polymer matrix to form a material that is lightweight, durable and easy to clean. 




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SYSTEM COMPONENTS

PANELS

• Panels are frameless and consist of a decorative face material, structural support that varies based on material selection, and support cleats that mate with the panel subsystem. See page 2 for panel face material options.

PANEL SUBSYSTEM

- LEVELr subsystem utilizes a dual-cleat panel attachment system. See page 1 for panel subsystem components.
- Most standard system components are delivered in 12' lengths to be cut to size during installation. This allows for minor adjustments during installation to meet on-site conditions.

PERIMETER FINS AND REVEAL FINS

- Perimeter Fins and Reveal Fins have a 1/8" width and are available in bead-blasted stainless steel or black anodized aluminum.
- · Perimeter Fins are standard system components; Reveal Fins are optional.

BASE

- Standard bases consist of a stainless steel, Elemental Metal, or Fused Metal facing applied to an extruded aluminum substrate.
- The standard base is recessed 2" from the face of the panel. The base can be shimmed to any depth.
- If you would like to use your own base or no base, the system can be provided without a base.

• Corners are available in bead-blasted stainless steel or black anodized aluminum.


Outside Open Corner




Outside Closed Corner

• Corners are available in bead-blasted stainless steel or black anodized aluminum, or any of our standard stainless steel, Elemental Metal, or Fused Metal finishes.


CORNER DETAILS

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INSTALLATION

WALL PANEL INSTALLATION	PANEL REPLACEMENT
LEVELr installation is designed to be straight-forward and efficient. Many field conditions can be accommodated by adhering to the following installation sequence.	If panels are ever damaged due to accident or vandalism, replacement panels can be ordered from Forms+Surfaces.
• First, the Base Extrusions are attached with self-tapping screws, shimming as required to establish a planar basis for the wall cladding system.	The attachment system permits one panel to be removed without disturbing those around it, keeping downtime to a minimum.
Perimeter L-Channels, and Reveal Fin Mounting Extrusions and Corners (if specified) are set next and leveled to the plane just created.	a minimum.
Next, the Top and Bottom Cleats are installed, followed by the Reveal Fin Grips and the Reveal Fins (if specified).	
Perimeter Fins are then attached to the Perimeter L-Channels.	
Lastly, the panels are engaged via a cleat support system. Note: panels can be installed and replaced independently and in any order.
