




# Our Design Process

# Made by hand

## TO LAST A LIFETIME

YOUR HUPPÉ FURNITURE GOES THROUGH SOME 20 STAGES IN THE PRODUCTION PROCESS BEFORE IT GETS TO YOUR HOME. AT EACH STAGE, WE WORK SLOWLY AND CAREFULLY TO ENSURE YOUR FURNITURE WILL STAND THE TEST OF TIME.

## Production


Once our team receives your order, your furniture goes into production. The panels are meticulously cut to the exact dimensions and all parts are prepared for assembly. Wood veneers are carefully installed over the panels and edges. Solid wood parts are planed, cut, and machined with the utmost attention to detail.

## Finishing

This critical stage is when your Huppé furniture becomes a high-quality work of art. Finishing includes almost a dozen different processes, completed by hand according to each customer's wishes.

- Wood sanded prior to finishing
- Stained with a stain sprayer
- Stain wiped down by hand
- Two coats of sealant applied
- Sealant is sanded
- Lacquer applied in a hermetically sealed room
- Dried using infrared heat, which improves evaporation of solvents and gives a longer-lasting finish

## Assembly

We use a combination of glue and screws for outstanding quality and unfailing durability. Next, our expert woodworkers make the necessary adjustments for your Huppé furniture to meet the most exacting standards.


## Upholstery

If applicable, your furniture moves on to the upholstery stage. Your sofa's frame is made of solid wood guaranteed for life and assembled with screws, staples, and glue. Next, we put foam and webbing over the frame to give the piece the comfort and support you need. Imported from Italy, the rubber and polypropylene bands are installed and adjusted one by one for optimum comfort. Each piece of fabric is cut by hand with scissors and sewn with heavy-duty thread. The result—a high-quality sofa you can enjoy for many years to come.



## Preparation for delivery

This Huppé piece has been produced just for you. All that's left is to add lighting and hardware, depending on the item, and then it will soon be delivered to your home, anywhere in the world. From our family to yours.

## Pride That Keeps On Growing

At Huppé, we're proud to use wood as a raw material and we're aware of our industry's impact on forests. For our 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary, we're taking action on sustainable development. For each Huppé bed sold worldwide, we undertake to plant a tree. Made possible with support from Tree Canada, this initiative will see about 3,000 trees planted in Canada each year.



## FSC-certified Suppliers

This is your assurance that our suppliers source their wood from forests managed responsibly in compliance with strict standards to protect communities and the environment. Certification also ensures your product is traceable, from forest to showroom.

## Low VOC

Huppé is also committed to lowering volatile organic compound emissions that are harmful to the environment and to health. We use only formaldehyde-free glues in our production process. Our paints are also very low VOC.

## Sustainable Facilities

Since 2014 Huppé has invested more than \$2 million in centralizing operations, expanding infrastructure, installing a new air exchanger, and purchasing a compressor and heat recovery system. This has reduced our annual heat consumption by 75%, taken 130 trailers off the road, and lowered the greenhouse gas emissions of 41 cars.

## BIRCH

Birch is a precious wood with a fine, even grain. Light in color with natural pink hues, birch is malleable but durable, making it ideal for decorative veneers.

## AMERICAN BLACK WALNUT

Decidedly luxurious, American black walnut is an exceptional wood. This species is prized for its dark color, variegated grain and satiny finish.

## WHITE OAK

Recognized for its remarkable strength and flexibility, white oak features long, elegant grain lines with an open texture. It's light in color but can be stained in a variety of shades for a myriad of uses.

# Glass and Lacquers

Lacquer adds depth to our colors and designs. Huppé uses a microtextured lacquer for a matt look that is much more resistant to marks than the lacquers normally used for this type of finish. We also offer lacquered glass. Choose regular glass for a glossy look and acid-etched glass for a matt effect. This option is very popular for adding texture and contrast to your furniture.



# Natural stone, a timeless choice

Although natural stone is a completely different material from fabric, lacquer, and wood, the qualities we seek are always the same: beauty, durability, and functionality. The stones we've selected have two more major pluses—they are both sourced in North America and can be cut to 3/8 of an inch, a very rare quality that makes it easier to incorporate them in our furniture. We reinforce the stone with carbon fiber mesh and use it to enhance our tables, sideboards, and chests without adding unnecessary weight.






