

ABOUT **Anemone** by Ralph Frickel

Secrets of the reef. With its bold design the Anemone pendant reflects the elegance and grandeur of the French Empire crystal chandeliers, yet with a modern twist inspired by the underwater world. Available as suspension, wall, floor and table lamp.





ABOUT **Cloche** by Ralph Frickel

Chic like a lady's hat. A tribute to the French Haute Couture of the early twentieth century, and a nod to the classic lampshades of the 1920s. The thickness of the cables increases with the size. Available as suspension, wall, floor and table lamp.





ABOUT **Pelagia** by Ralph Frickel




ABOUT **Roundabout** by Ralph Frickel


ABOUT **Alistair** by Edward van Vliet

The long slim version of the Alistair is a modern fixture but still captures the eastern ambience.




ABOUT **Apple Mood** by Malika Novi

The pure geometric shape becomes elegant on this Belgian bluestone base.





ABOUT **Moon** by Jan Pauwels

ABOUT **Cosmos** by Jan Pauwels








ABOUT **Crystal Galaxy** by Jan Pauwels

Curled LED circuit boards and tiny metal rods are the only two basic elements of this light fixture. They give the lamp its structure and shape.




ABOUT **Fieltebek** by Jan Pauwels

A fish skeleton made of illuminated metal rods. Available in 3 sizes and 2 finishes.



ABOUT **Frame** by Jan Pauwels

Strong & characteristic light frame. LED circuit boards and tiny metal rods are the only two basic elements of this light fixture. They give the lamp its structure and shape.





ABOUT **IO** by Jos Muller

The expression of duality. The name refers to a "bit", the basic unit of the binary numeral system used in computing and digital communications. A bit can have only one of two values, most commonly represented by an "1" and an "0".





ABOUT **Ixion** by Maurizio Ferrari

A frozen juggling throw. At any time the diagonal free hanging light tubes create an interesting composition. Play with angles and modify your own lamp.





ABOUT **Julia** by Daniel Becker

A reinterpretation of the classic textile plissé shade. Julia series includes suspensions, chandeliers, wall, floor and table lamps. Each one consists of two shades: the outer is handmade of brass, while the inner is made of translucent glass. Both shades are connected to a classic table lamp in a way that signifies the present archetypal gesture.













ABOUT **Lum** by Estefania Johnson

Creating illuminating walls. This Chilean designer was inspired by Chile's most obtainable raw material, copper. Using basic panels and light panels make it possible to create different design configurations according to the aesthetical and illuminating need of each space.






ABOUT **Match** by Jos Muller

The size of a small matchbox is enough to produce light. The multiple version is mesmerising as each element turns and finds its own way. The Match has a coloured or transparent detail.





ABOUT **Melody** by Sybille van Gammeren
The Art Deco style and love for music were the inspiration for the designer to create this light. The characteristic stainless steel combined with the gold leaf finish gives a frivolous effect.





ABOUT **Mira** by Jan Pauwels

Swarovski crystals are sparkling in this transparent structure.
This elegance makes the chandelier timeless.





ABOUT **Nobilis** by Jan Pauwels


A modern reinterpretation of grandma's old chandelier. The E10 light bulbs and tiny metal rods are the only two basic elements of this light fixture. They give the lamp its shape and structure.





ABOUT **Orion** by Jan Pauwels

Create your own indoor skyline by placing two or more Orions. The effect is marvelous. With its asymmetric architectural structure, this suspension perfectly fits into a modern interior.





ABOUT **Orion** by Jan Pauwels

The first fixture of Jan Pauwels where he scaled down the tiny E10 light bulb to an even smaller LED printed circuit board. This asymmetrical light is named after one of the most notorious constellations in the sky.





ABOUT **Philae** by Jan Pauwels

Autumn storm, falling leaves, make any combination you like. By playing with the length of the cables, and the number and sizes, you create your own lighting installation.




ABOUT **Quartet** by Jan des Bouvrie
Robust but elegant square shaped suspension, floor and
table lamp. The shade is available in 3 finishes.





ABOUT **Rontonton** by Edward van Vliet
Tribute to the shadow. This light gives a fantastic shadow play on the nearby wall or ceiling. Because of the pattern, the lamp is also beautiful when it is switched off. Available as a suspension, floor and table lamp.







ABOUT **Rosetta** by Jan Pauwels

Travelling light. Rosetta travelled 10 years to explore space. Rosetta is both square and curved, and therefore mesmerisingly eye-catching above a long table.





ABOUT **Royal BB** by Edward van Vliet
"Royal Bombombola", as it was originally baptized, is a majestic modern take on the age-old chandelier with a definitive festive mood added to it.



ABOUT **Royal BB** by Edward van Vliet

The chandelier shows myriads of shiny reflecting lights, and balls of various sizes and intensity, which reminds us of rising bubbles in a champagne glass.





ABOUT **Ruby** by Ravage


Interior jewelry. An enlarged link of a bracelet, hypermodern metalworking techniques combined with artisanal stained glass. Two widely separated worlds forged together.






ABOUT **Sparks** by Daniel Becker


Inspired by a sparkling fire, the designer created a modular lighting system consisting of three different modules with the ability to arrange various configurations to form a three-dimensional structure.

The installation solutions are endless and fit in every architectural situation.




ABOUT **Sparks** by Daniel Becker



ABOUT **Torch** by Studio Quasar


Torches should be placed in the corridors like they did in the early centuries. Modernized in casted aluminium or bronze.

ABOUT **Universe Disc** by Jan Pauwels


The round version of the Universe is available in various sizes and finishes.





ABOUT **Universe Square** by Jan Pauwels



ABOUT **Universe Square** by Jan Pauwels


By adding vertical glass tubes, the Universe Square looks immense by showing myriads of shiny reflecting lights.


